In response to clarification sought by one of the applicants, the following is issued by the Client:

S#	Queries	Response from PSPC
1	In reference to the REOI document Section 2 Instructions to Applicants, item F. Project Inspection and Site Visit, will PSPC arrange for a site visit schedule for the applicants or is it the responsibility of the applicants to arrange for a schedule with PSPC? If it is the latter, please provide the contact name and details of the PSPC representative so we could coordinate the site visit schedule.	Applicant has to arrange his own site visits, under the intimation of PSPC.
2	In reference to Appendix 1A Format for Power of Attorney (POA) for Signing Proposal, it was specified on the template that the POA has to be On a Stamp Paper of appropriate value. If the applicant is the lead international firm, is it acceptable that the POA is in the company's letterhead? It may not be possible for international firms to submit EOI from overseas to solicit the stamp paper.	As per EOI document, firm should submit documents.
3	The REOI document is requesting the applicants to provide an Undertaking that the applicant has not been black-listed by any Government Agency/Authority. Does this Undertaking need to be on a legal stamp	As per EOI document, firm should submit documents.

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	paper or an international firm can provide this on the firm's letterhead?	
4	It is our intent to hire local firms in the "sub-consultant/ association" category. On the wordings on the forms, would it be acceptable for PSPC if we replace the word consortium with sub-consultant or association?	If you are a single entity then you can specify the sub consultant in your Technical Proposal at RFP stage. If you are consortium then you cannot change the word "consortium".
